

CARE INSTRUCTIONS

- 3. Avoid Chemicals: Avoid using chemicals or alcoholcontaining products to clean the wood or epoxy surfaces, as they can remove wood finishes and cloud epoxy surfaces.
- 4. Control Environmental Factors: Keep the wood and epoxy furniture away from direct sunlight and extreme temperature changes. These factors can lead to discoloration of the epoxy and warping of the wood.
 - a. Dehumidifier: Using a dehumidifier, especially in the summer when temperature and humidity levels are high, can remove extra moisture from the air and protect your wood from warping.
- 5. **Use Protectors:** Always use coasters, placemats, and trivets to protect the table from heat and scratches.
- 6. **Restore shine:** If the epoxy surface appears dull, apply a non-toxic marine wax (like Meguiar's) to restore shine. Follow the product instructions closely for best results.
